IRS W2 Changes

The good news for 2008 is that there are no changes to the 2007 format. What this means to you is that the application that Vision provided to you last year will continue to provide a solution for the ASP product line.

The 2009 Federal Tax Schedule (Circular E) is now available for downloading. 2009 Federal Tax Schedule (Circular E)

ASP customers will find the Withholding Allowance Schedule on page 36, the Annual Tax Schedule located on page 39, Table 7. Social Security and Medicare Taxes are defined on page 17. Setup your earnings limit as 106,800, the deduct limit as 6621.60, and the rate remains at .062. Note: If you have multiple Social Security and Medicare rates, adjust accordingly.

Vision customers; your applications will automatically be updated January 1st with Click-Once.


